SPECIAL EVENTS AND FUNDRAISING

Special events and fundraising volunteers will play a key role in planning, coordinating and the delivery of major gala events, annual gift campaigns, and other major fundraising events to ensure the on-going sustainability and accessibility of the Gallery programs.

Commitment

- make a minimum commitment of 1 year
- attend regularly scheduled education meetings to learn about new exhibitions, programs, and events
- attend scheduled fundraising committee meetings
- committee meeting frequency will vary depending on current and upcoming activities

Training

- attend training sessions as developed by gallery staff
- participate in emergency and safety procedures training as required

Duties & Responsibilities

- has excellent interpersonal skills and genuinely enjoys helping people
- provide guests with a positive impression of the gallery by maintaining a friendly and approachable manner when dealing with guests, staff, and other volunteers
- maintain a relaxed and confident demeanour
- ability to work in a team environment
- undergo a Vulnerable Sector Screening security check, at the expense of the Gallery**

** Costs will be reimbursed after three months of successful volunteer involvement, at the point that a volunteer graduates from a *provisional* to an *active* volunteer.

- abide by the *Judith & Norman ALIX Art Gallery* policies & procedures for volunteers
- have access to email and the internet
- attend a general orientation session as arranged by gallery staff
- undergo specific training in their assigned placements
- discuss any questions, issues, or problems with their gallery supervisor in their placement area
- have obtained an appropriate Vulnerable Sector Screening security police check

Volunteering at the *Judith & Norman ALIX Art Gallery* will provide an opportunity for you to connect with people who share your interests and gain a behind-the-scenes view of the gallery and its operation. As volunteer members, you will have additional benefits as well including discounts on gallery programming and invitations to exhibition previews. It's also a great way for high-school students to accumulate their volunteer hours.

How to become a Volunteer - Next Steps

Staff will be contacting everyone who has filled out an "expression of interest" form and invite them to a detailed information session early in 2012. At that session all interested volunteers will be asked to fill out an application form, which will also be available at the reception desk and on line at www.artgallerylambton.ca. Candidates will be interviewed, and all volunteers will go through a screening process that varies depending on the volunteer position. Screening procedures can include, but are not necessarily limited to, an application form, an interview, and reference checks.
